Want to do something to stop global warming?

Here are 10 simple things you can do and how much carbon dioxide you will save doing them.

Change a light: replace one regular bulb with a compact fluorescent light will save 150 pounds of carbon dioxide per year.

Drive less: walk, bike, carpool or take metro transit more often. You'll save one pound of carbon dioxide for every mile you don't drive.

Recycle more: you can save 2,400 pounds of carbon dioxide per year by recycling just half of your household waste.

Check your tires: Keeping your tires inflated properly can improve your gas mileage by more than 3%. Every gallon of gasoline saved keeps 20 pounds of carbon dioxide out of the atmosphere.

Use less hot water: It takes a lot of energy to heat water. Use less hot water by installing a low-flow showerhead (350 pounds of CO₂ saved per year and washing your clothes in cold water will save 500 pounds per year).

Avoid products with over packaging: you can save 1,200 pounds of carbon dioxide if you cut down your garbage by 10%.

Adjust your thermostat: moving your thermostat down just 2 degrees in winter and 2 degrees up in summer will save about 2,000 of carbon dioxide per year.

Plant a tree: a single tree will absorb one ton of carbon dioxide over its lifetime!

Turn off electric devices: simply turn off your television, DVD player, stereo and computer when you're not using them will save thousands of pounds of carbon dioxide per year.
